At the session held on 13 May 2008, the Executive Council of AP Vojvodina reached a decision on the number of students enrolling Master– and doctoral studies at faculties within the University of Novi Sad who are financed from the budget of AP Vojvodina in the academic 2008/09.

Master – and doctoral studies at faculties of the University of Novi Sad financed from the provincial budget, can be enrolled by 1.295 students. In case the Ministry of Education does not give its approval for the number of students financed from the budget that would be in compliance with this decision, the number of students enrolling Master– and doctoral studies in the academic 2008/09 will be financed from the budget of AP Vojvodina up to the number of students approved by the Ministry of Education.

According to this decision, University of Novi Sad announces

2. Eligibility criteria:

Sports Medicine and Physiotherapy

Completed four-year studies at a faculty, i.e. acquired 240 ECTS.

Management in Education

Completed four-year studies at a faculty, i.e. acquired 240 ECTS.

Techniques and Management in Applied Arts

Four-year higher education degree in any study programme, i.e. acquired 240 ECTS in the field of visual communications that include fine arts, applied- and drama arts, graphical engineering and design, architecture, as well as sciences related to these fields.

Gender Studies

Completed four-year studies at a faculty, i.e. acquired 240 ECTS.

Sports Management

Completed four-year studies at a faculty, i.e. acquired 240 ECTS.

CAESAR

European Studies

Completed four-year studies of higher education in any study programme, i.e. acquired 240 ECTS.

European and International Sports Law

Completed four-year studies or more (minimum 240 ECTS) in the following fields: law, sports, economics and management.

Students have to have a knowledge of the English language to be able to attend lectures as well as to communicate successfully with lecturers and mentors (proof: adequate certificate or successfully passed test organized by ACIMSI together with the Faculty of Philosophy, University of Novi Sad).

Note: costs of a test in the amount of 4.000,00 dinars or 50,00 euros, are covered by the candidates enrolling postgraduate studies.

European Master Course in the Field of Child Rights

Completed Bachelor studies (240 ECTS) in the field of Social sciences or Humanities.

Students have to have a knowledge of the English language to be able to attend lectures, to read literature and communicate successfully with lecturers, as well as to study (in the second semester) and defend a Master thesis at one of the partner EU universities. As a proof of knowledge of English, an adequate certificate will be taken into consideration as well as a motivation letter written in English (submitted together with the application).

- **from June 23, to October 10, 2008**

4. Required documents for submitting the application:

Apart from the filled application form (can be found on the University web site – www.ns.ac.yu), candidates should also submit:

- original diploma (to present for inspection) and verified photocopy of diploma and
- short CV

When enrolling, a candidate also submits a birth certificate and 2 photographs in a size 3,5 x 4,5 cm.

Study programme

a) completed Master studies (300 ECTS) in the field of environmental engineering or other related fields that lasted for 5 (five) years obtaining minimum 300 ECTS

b) completed four-year Bachelor studies (240 ECTS) in the related fields.

Medical Physics and Medical Engineering

a) completed Master studies (300 ECTS) in the field of medical physics, physics, physical chemistry at Faculty of Technical Sciences or any other technical faculty (electrical engineering and others) at other universities, Faculty of Medicine.

b) completed four-year Bachelor studies (240 ECTS) in the related fields.

Meteorology and Environmental Modelling

Study programme

- Modelling of Polluting Material Transport
- Aviation Meteorology
- Ultraviolet Radiation in the Environment – Modelling, Effects and Measurements

a) completed academic studies in the relevant fields of meteorology, physics or other related fields that lasted for 5 (five) years obtaining minimum 300 ECTS

b) completed four-year Bachelor studies (240 ECTS) in the related fields.

DOCTORAL STUDIES

2. Eligibility criteria:

Sports Medicine and Physiotherapy

- a) completed Master studies that lasted for 5 (five) years obtaining minimum 300 ECTS and the minimum average grade of 8,00 (eight)
- b) completed specialist studies with the minimum average grade of 8,00 (eight)
- c) adequate number of passed exams at postgraduate Master studies, obtaining minimum 60 ECTS.

Management in Education

- a) completed Master studies that lasted for 5 (five) years obtaining minimum 300 ECTS and the minimum average grade of 8,00 (eight)
- b) completed specialist studies with the the minimum average grade of 8,00 (eight)
- c) adequate number of passed exams at postgraduate Master studies, obtaining minimum 60 ECTS.

Environmental Engineering

- a) completed Master studies (300 ECTS) in the field of environmental engineering or other related fields that lasted for 5 (five) years with minimum 300 ECTS and the minimum average grade of 8,00 (eight)
- b) completed specialist studies in the field of environmental engineering with the minimum average grade of 8,00 (eight), when a candidate enrolls the second year having recognized all of his exams he passed, on condition that he passed all obligatory exams from the first year of doctoral studies.
- c) Bachelor studies and defended Master thesis in related fields according to previous laws.

Medical Physics and Medical Engineering

- a) completed Master studies (300 ECTS) in the field of medical physics that lasted for 5 (five) years with minimum 300 ECTS and the minimum average grade of 8,00 (eight)
- b) completed specialist studies in the field of medical physics with the minimum average grade of 8,00 (eight), when a candidate enrolls the second year having recognized all of his exams he passed, on condition that he passed all obligatory exams from the first year of doctoral studies
- c) completed Bachelor studies and defended Master thesis at Faculty of Sciences – Department of Physics, Faculty of Physics, Faculty for Physical Chemistry, Faculty of Technical Sciences or Faculty of Medicine with the minimum average grade 8,00.

Gender Studies

- a) completed Master studies that lasted for 5 (five) years with minimum 300 ECTS and the minimum average grade of 8,00 (eight)
- b) completed specialist studies with the minimum average grade of 8,00 (eight).

Meteorology and Environmental Modelling

- a) completed Master studies in the field of physics, meteorology or other related fields that lasted for 5 (five) years with minimum 300 ECTS and the minimum average grade of 8,00 (eight)
- b) completed specialist studies in the field of meteorology and environmental modelling with the minimum average grade of 8,00 (eight), when a candidate enrolls the second year having recognized all of his exams he passed, on condition that he passes all basic subjects from the first year. Doctoral studies can be enrolled by those candidates who completed their studies and defended Master thesis in related fields according to previous laws.

4. Required documents for submitting the application:

Apart from the filled application form (can be found on the University web site – www.ns.ac.yu), candidates should also submit:

- original diploma (to present for inspection) and verified photocopy of diploma and
- short CV

When enrolling, a candidate also submits a birth certificate and 2 photographs in a size 3,5 x 4,5 cm.

Note:

Realization of the decision on the number of students at doctoral studies who will be financed from the budget of Republic of Serbia, depends on the Ministry of Education.

Specialist studies can be enrolled by unlimited number of foreign students.

Foreign citizens and candidates pay themselves the scholarship for specialist and doctoral studies.

Each center will determine the minimal number of students at the beginning of the programme and candidates will be informed about that immediately after the open competition closes.
