



University of Bologna's International Staff Training Week

After the successful first edition of 2017, UNIBO International Office is going to organise a second edition of the international staff training week. It will take place **from 14 to 18 May 2018 in Bologna**. This international training event is open to staff from UNIBO partner universities in the Erasmus+ KA107 program (International Credit Mobility).

The training program is conceived as a forum to discuss general issues facing **Higher Education today in a globalized world**. It will be an occasion to jointly reflect on **challenges and opportunities** that Universities are to take on when dealing with their **international dimension**. A key to success for this training week is therefore active participation. Attendees should be staff working on university internationalization matters including mobility programs, international student services, international cooperation and project management. Participants are expected to bring into the discussion examples from their own institutions and/or innovative approaches to the issues addressed, including through a presentation during a specific session.

Each day will be dedicated to a topic. The program is going to be organized in general sessions comprising different presentations related to the day theme. General sessions might be followed by round tables/work groups where colleagues will share views, expertise and practices.
